OUR HISTORY

There was a further wave of emigration in the mid to late 20th century of Khoja families from East Africa to the West, primarily to the UK, USA and Canada, notably with the expulsion of Asians from Uganda by Idi Amin in 1972. The community has since organised itself into an organised network with Jamaats (centres) around the globe, stretching from Canada to Australia.
