




British Muslims are geographically diverse



What does this mean?

- Amongst the 2.7 million Muslims in England & Wales in 2011, 75% live in four regions: London, West Midlands, the North West and Yorkshire and The Humber.
- Significantly sized communities live in other parts of the UK from Land's End to Stornoway, indicating Muslims are part of the social fabric of Britain's multi-religious society.
- Within each region there are also areas of high and low concentrations, for example there are 35 Local Authority Districts (LADs) where Muslims make up 10% of the population or more.
- In 2011 there were also 77,000 Muslims in Scotland and 4,000 in Northern Ireland.
